Dental Assistants

Entry wages (2014): \$12.24 per hour or \$25,459 annually

Projected growth (2015-2025): Faster than average at 20.1% in Tarrant County

What will you do?

Dental Assistants duties vary by dental offices and each state they work in. They perform tasks from patient care, x-rays, recordkeeping and scheduling patient appointments. Including lab tasks such as taking dental impressions or prepare materials to make impressions for crowns all under the supervision of the dentist.

Where will you work?

Dental Assistants work in dental clinics, dental offices, hospitals and government agencies. They work under the supervision of the dentist. There are 3 Types of dental assistants: Qualified Dental Assistant (Not Certified), Registered Dental Assistant (Texas), and Certified Dental Assistant (National).

What Experience do you need?

Dental assistants who do not have formal education in dental assisting may learn their duties through onthe-job training as a non-certified dental assistant. They are not allowed to duties such as taking ex-ray and many others without a dentist supervising. Employers prefer credentialed dental assistants to be able to perform specific duties without their supervision.

What type of Job Training do I need?

The Texas State Board of Dental Examiners (TSBDE) <u>Texas State Board of Dental Examiners</u> is the state authority on certifications to perform dental assisting duties in Texas. There are four certifications: Registered Dental Assistant, Nitrous Oxide Monitoring, Coronal Polishing, and Pit & Fissure Sealant. Renewal of RDA certification is annual. After the first RDA renewal, the person must attend Continuing Education classes and complete them to renew the certificate the following year. Must also have a current CPR certification to be able to renew dental assistant certification.

Tarrant County College, Northeast Campus, is the <u>only</u> TSBDE state approved training provider for all 4 types of certifications.
