



MUST BE **ALL** OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 16 to 24
- Citizen or non-citizen eligible to work in the United States
- Meet Selective Service requirements (18-24 males only)

AND
→

MUST BE **ONE** OF THE FOLLOWING:

- A school dropout - an individual between 19 and 24 at the time of enrollment
- Between the ages of 16 and 18 but has not attended school for at least the most recent completed school year calendar quarter
- A recipient of a secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent who is a low income individual and is basic skills deficient OR an English language learner
- An individual subject to juvenile or adult justice system
- A homeless individual, a homeless child or youth, runaway, in foster care or has aged out of foster care system
- An individual who is pregnant or parenting
- An individual with a disability
- A low-income individual who requires additional assistance to enter or complete an educational program or secure or hold employment

YOUNG ADULT PROGRAM BENEFITS:

- Paid work experience [internship] - year-round or summer
- Alternative secondary school services
- Occupational skills training in demand industry sectors
- Leadership development
- Workplace mentoring
- Support Services including:
 - Linages to community services
 - Transportation assistance
 - Housing assistance
 - Needs-related payments
 - Educational testing assistance
 - Reasonable accommodations for youth with disabilities
 - Referrals to health care
 - Assistance with uniforms or other appropriate work attire and work-related tools, including items such as protective eye gear
 - Assistance with books, fees, and school supplies, and other necessary items for students enrolled in postsecondary education classes
 - Payment and fees for employment and training-related applications, tests, and certifications
- Financial literacy education
- Entrepreneurial Training
- Labor Market and employment information about in-demand industries
- Activities that help prepare youth for post-secondary education
