The Tarrant County Workforce Development Board, doing business as Workforce Solutions for Tarrant County (WSTC), is seeking proposals from qualified organizations to manage and operate Tarrant County's Workforce Center System. The initial year of service for the selected provider will begin on October 1, 2026 and end on September 30, 2027. WSTC may extend the contract for an additional year up to four times, pending annual review and successful achievement of goals and performance measures.

Funds will be available in Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families/Choices (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Non-Custodial Parent Program (NCP), and Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessment (RESEA) funding, and may include various levels of funding from other sources such as Wagner Peyser Employment Services, Trade Adjustment Act, and other various discretionary and special project funds.

A Bidder's Conference will be held on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 beginning at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom. The deadline to submit proposals is noon on Friday, April 24, 2026.
